

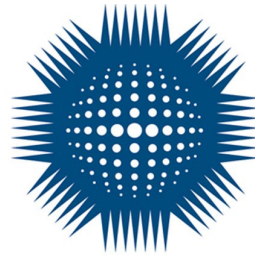

# ***NEBOSH National Diploma in Environmental Management*** ***(distance learning with tutorials)***

The NEBOSH National Diploma in Environmental Management is aimed at individuals involved in environmental risk management and environmental management systems within their organisations. Holders of this qualification may use the designatory letters EnvDipNEBOSH after their name. IOSH CPD participants may allocate CPD credits for attendance at this course. In addition, holders of the Environmental Diploma are eligible for Associate Membership of IIRSM, and for Associate Membership of the Institute of Environmental Management and Assessment (IEMA). The Environmental Diploma provides a sound basis for progression to MSc level.

The syllabus is based on, and requires candidates to understand the principle pieces of UK legislation which in turn are based on EU legislation. This is fairly widely adopted by many companies and countries throughout the world and is becoming increasingly relevant to international students.

## **Entry Qualification**

NEBOSH does not stipulate entry qualifications for this award but candidates should have a good standard of written English.

## **Distance Learning**

Course materials consist of printed notes and coursework. Coursework may be submitted for marking by post or e-mail. The course is supported by non-compulsory tutorials held in Coventry, in the autumn and spring. Dates are given below for the tutorials in autumn 2010 and spring 2011, together with the examination dates.

## **Environmental Diploma Assessment**

To obtain the National Diploma in Environmental Management candidates must pass a written examination (ED1) and submit an environmental project (ED2) based on a proforma of audit questions. Candidates are responsible for finding their own site to audit. Examinations are held in June and December (see dates above).

## **Course Fee**

The course fee is £600 + VAT (£705), including support for 12 months, so candidates have the choice of two exam sittings. VAT is not applicable for candidates domicile outside the UK.

## *Examination Fees*

### **NEBOSH Fees**

Students resident in the UK will generally pay NEBOSH examination registration fees directly to NEBOSH. However, these can be added onto the course fee if required. Overseas students may pay NEBOSH fees through ATM Safety and Environment.

### **Exam Venue**

#### *Coventry*

ATM Safety & Environment hold their examinations in Coventry. Students sitting an exam for the first time in Coventry do not pay any exam invigilation fees but students re-sitting an exam are charged £30 + VAT in addition to the NEBOSH registration fee.

#### *Other locations in the UK*

Other course providers hold examinations in other parts of the country. Students can take exams with another course provider if they obtain their permission and pay their invigilation fee.

#### *Overseas*

NEBOSH allow their examinations to be taken through the British Council (BC) provided the office overseas is one that conducts exams. Countries where the British Council do not run exams include Ireland, Australia, New Zealand, USA and Canada. In Ireland ATM safety & Environment has made arrangements for NEBOSH exams to be held in Dublin at a local Business School. In other countries such as Australia, New Zealand, USA and Canada arrangements can be made for exams to be taken at local Universities.

#### *Overseas charges*

The British Council normally charge a set rate for exams and a courier fee payable in local currency before the exam is taken. ATM Safety & Environment also charge £25 with the exam registration fee, to partly cover the outward courier fee charged to us by NEBOSH (see table below).
